Reunion Planning Meeting: Alumni Programs staff will contact all class officers to coordinate a reunion planning meeting at least one year prior to the class reunion. This initial meeting will be held at the most advantageous time and location to garner the most class officer participation possible (conference calls, lunch meetings and off-campus locations are all possibilities). This meeting will focus on the schedule for class reunions, a planning timeline, and other details needed to promote classmate attendance and class gift participation.

Reunion Guidance: Alumni Association Staff will provide additional solicitation guidance and event-planning expertise for both reunion committees throughout the year prior to the reunion.

Alumni Records Department

The Alumni Records Department maintains the database for all UMaine alumni and friends. The Alumni Records Department is responsible for maintaining the following biographical information: name changes, home/business addresses, home/business phone and fax numbers, cell phone numbers, email addresses, deceased updates, activity, committee and student activity updates. Information is provided to individuals or groups (*such as members of a class or from a particular fraternity*), consistent with the Association's policies with regard to privacy and the dissemination of information. (For example, information about UMaine alumni is NEVER made available for non-UMaine purposes or for use by organizations not affiliated with UMaine.)
